

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF PUBLIC SELECTION FOR N° 1 GRANT FOR RESEARCH**  
**(Italian law 30 December 2010, n.240, art.22)**

**Description**

The Scuola Normale Superiore announces a selection, based on work to date, for n. 1 research contract named “*Conceiving differences, countering inequalities: the Analysis of discourses and practices in some contemporary feminist movements*” as part of the project MUR\_PRO3\_2021-23\_CONG\_RIC\_CAIANI entitled “*Sostenibilità sociale e diseguglianze di genere: università, politica ed economia*”, funded among the program PRO3 2021-23.

In order to respond to the PRO3 project, the requested research activity will have to examine, in a critical and comparative perspective, the discourses and political practices that some feminist movements enact in order to define and counter inequalities and gender inequalities. In particular, the work will have to investigate the contemporary Italian scene: the movement “Non una di meno”, which defines itself as feminist and transfeminist, and the constellation that identifies itself under the label of “radical feminism”, which brings together critical positions on the concept of gender and reflects on transgender and nonbinary identities.

Duration of the contract: 1 year

Gross remuneration, inclusive of all taxes: € 25,000

Application deadline: 13 July 2022.

Information about the selection procedure can be found below. Candidates are invited to read the official announcement (*Bando*) and to follow exclusively its detailed instructions should they decide to apply.

**Requisites**

Eligible candidates must have completed a PhD in Political Philosophy or History of political thought. Candidates who have completed the aforementioned degrees abroad may also apply, if said degrees are recognized as equivalent to Italian degrees;

Knowledge of English language is also required to carry out the research activity.

**How to apply**

Candidates with all the aforementioned requisites who wish to participate in the selection process must submit:

- a) the application, based on the attached model (**Att. A - Application form**), written on paper with original signature under penalty of exclusion (unless the candidates choose to send the application form using a PEC e-mail address);
- b) the photocopy (non-authenticated) of a valid identification document;
- c) a signed and up-dated curriculum vitae containing a detailed description of the educational career and professional experience;
- d) the publications, including also the PhD thesis, and any other document that the candidate believes may be useful to the evaluation of her/his application (it is mandatory to attach the publications that the candidate intends to submit to the evaluation of the Committee). The publications must be provided exclusively on a digital storage device (cd, USB flash drive etc.), in pdf format. For those unpublished texts accepted for publication, the candidate must include the relative document in its final form and the publisher’s certificate or a detailed substitute statement of affidavit confirming that the relative text has been accepted for publication (please use attachment B);
- e) a signed list of the submitted publications.

If the application is presented directly to the “Ufficio Protocollo” [Documents Registry Office] of the Scuola Normale or sent by registered mail or courier, the digital storage device must contain also a scanned copy of the application, the curriculum vitae and the list of publications.

In order to submit the application and documentation listed above, candidates must use one of these options:

- a) candidates can present the application form and documentation directly, during office hours (for information on opening hours please contact [protocollo@sns.it](mailto:protocollo@sns.it)), to the “Servizio Archivio, Protocollo e Posta” [Documents Registry Office] of the Scuola Normale, located at Via del Castelletto, n. 11, 56126 Pisa (Italy);
- b) candidates can send the application form and documentation by registered mail with acknowledgment of receipt or courier to the following address: Ufficio Protocollo della Scuola Normale Superiore, Via del Castelletto n. 11, 56126 Pisa (Italy). In this case, it is recommendable to write on the envelope “*Research grant The politicization of domestic spaces and the fight against gender discrimination*”;
- c) candidates can send the application form using the electronic mail only if they possess a personal certified electronic mail address (the Italian PEC - Posta Elettronica Certificata). In this case, they should send the application form to the address [protocollo@pec.sns.it](mailto:protocollo@pec.sns.it).

If applicants send their application via PEC - Posta Elettronica Certificata, the presentation of documents and publications on paper, CD or USB flash drive is not requested.

Any candidature sent from a simple electronic mail address, different from the one described above, will not be accepted.

No other delivery method will be accepted.
