

**Public competition for the recruitment of one Full Professor, under art. 18, par. 1 of the Law 240/2010, at the Faculty of Sciences of the Scuola Normale Superiore, Academic Recruitment Field 10/E1 Medieval Latin and romance philologies and literatures, academic discipline L-FIL-LET/09 Romance philology and linguistics**

**Description:** the professor recruited will be responsible for the teaching of courses for the academic discipline L-FIL-LET/09 in the undergraduate and PhD courses, as well as other teaching activities pertinent to the same sector, in compliance with the Statute and regulations, and in accordance with the specifications of the teaching plans established on a year-by-year basis by the relevant academic authorities. The successful applicant will also be required to follow undergraduate and PhD degree theses, organise seminars and conferences, and carry out research activities, developing his or her own autonomous lines of research, in the field of the tradition of Italian and Romance texts and their critical edition.

**Application deadline:** 22<sup>th</sup> July 2022 at 4 p.m. (European Summer Time)

**Admissions requirements:**

Participation is limited to applicants who conform to one of the following descriptions:

- a) scholars who have obtained the National Scientific Qualification pursuant to art. 16 of Law 240/2010 for the academic recruitment field or for one of the academic recruitment fields included in the same macro-sector, for the full professor position and for the equivalent functions;
- b) scholars who have obtained a qualification pursuant to Law 210/1998 for the academic discipline included in the academic recruitment field covered by the call or in one of the academic recruitment fields included in the same macro-sector, and for the rank specified in the call, provided that they have not already been appointed in the said capacity, limited to the period of their eligibility;
- c) Full Professors already employed in other Universities;
- d) scholars carrying out research or teaching activities abroad at university level in a tenured position equivalent to the rank of Full Professor, according to the Tables of Correspondence set out by Ministerial Decree of 01/09/2016 and subsequent amendments.

Applicants shall be admitted to the selection procedure with reserve. The Administration may at any moment exclude applicants for not having the aforementioned requirements or for finding themselves in a situation of irremediable incompatibility, by reasoned order from the General Secretary.

**How to apply:**

Applications for participation in the selection process, together with a scientific-professional CV and any publications and qualifications deemed relevant to the selection process, must be submitted telematically, using the online dedicated PICA procedure at the following link: <https://pica.cineca.it/sns>

The above mentioned link is available in the section of the SNS web site ([www.sns.it](http://www.sns.it)) dedicated to the selection procedure herein. The same section, as well as the PICA online procedure, includes the appropriate “Instructions”, which applicants are invited to consult.

The online PICA app can be accessed via SPID (the national public digital identity system), choosing, from the page listing the federations available, the institution Scuola Normale Superiore; alternatively, the procedure will require you to have an e-mail address in order to be able to register in the system.

Applicants will need to enter into the online PICA procedure all data required for the production of the application, and to attach the following documents, uploading them onto the procedure in PDF format:

- a) their scientific-professional CV;
- b) a non-authenticated photocopy of a valid identity document;
- c) a list of the publications that they intend to present for evaluation purposes, within the limit specified in Art.1 of the call, using the form reproduced in Attachment A to the call herein, which will be made available through the online PICA procedure;
- d) a copy of the publications specified in the list referred to in letter c) above, within the limit specified in Art.1 of the call; each publication may not exceed the space of 30 megabytes;
- e) a declaration relating to the verification of the minimal element connected to the possession of the parameters of scientific qualification indicated in Art.6, paragraph 1 letter B below: “Valutazione delle pubblicazioni scientifiche” (“Assessment of scientific publications”) using the form, included in Attachment B of the call herein, which will be made available through the online PICA procedure;
- f) any qualifications, among those declared in the CV, and/or documents proving them, that they intend to submit.

Until the deadline for the presentation of applications, the procedure can save any data inserted in draft mode, enabling their modification and/or integration.

By the established deadline referred to in paragraph 1, applications for participation in the selection must be filled in definitively in all their parts, signed, on pain of exclusion, in one of the modes indicated in paragraph 5 below, and presented – together with all the attachments – by means of the online procedure. The date of online presentation will be certified by the online procedure itself; candidates will be notified of the receipt of their application and the subsequent registration thereof in two separate e-mail messages. Each application will be attributed a separate identification number (application ID) and a registration number, both visible inside the application; the application ID must be used, together with the call code 22-PO-LFILLET09-01, for any subsequent communications.
