

**Announcement for the recruitment of 1 full time Technologist on a fixed-term contract  
Project PNRR “EBRAINS-Italy - European Brain ReseArch INfrastructureS-Italy”  
(Italian law 30 December 2010, no. 240, art.24-bis)**

***Description***

The Scuola Normale Superiore announces a public selection, by qualifications and oral test, for the recruitment, pursuant to Art. 24-bis of Law No. 240/2010, of 1 second-level Technologist on a fixed-term contract with remuneration equated with cat. D, salary status D4, with a full-time work schedule at the Struttura di gestione (Management Structure) (STG) of the Scuola di San Cataldo, which provides support to the Bio@SNS Biology Laboratory (Pisa site), with the task of providing technical and administrative support to the research project EBRAINS-Italy - European Brain ReseArch INfrastructureS-Italy

The project aims at enabling the clinical and experimental activities in the health sector to benefit to the full from the most avant garde modelling, computational and analytical technologies available in the field of neurosciences. The main goal is to gather in a single research infrastructure various groups of top-level scientific, technical and organisational capability in the field of experimental/theoretical neurosciences operating in Italy, integrating the activities in order to create synergies and to give rise to a substantial increase in scientific, industrial and social research throughout the European Union

In particular, within the compass of the guidelines and of the co-ordination of scientific project managers and of the structure of assignment, the Technologist recruited will be carrying out research development activities, including the development of intellectual property, the development of patents and the industrialisation of the results of research.

The professional recruited, who will be operating at levels of autonomy and responsibility in line with category D in accordance with the prevailing CCNL (National Collective Labour Agreement) of the Education and Research division, will be required to possess skills and knowledge in the following fields:

proven knowledge of methods of selection of antibodies against proteins with post-translational modifications;

proven knowledge in the field of technological transfer relating to the registration of patents, and to the development and exploitation of intellectual property;

Computer skills regarding the use of the Office suite, e-mail, videoconferencing tools and web access:

knowledge of English.

**Duration of the contract:**

20 months maximum and in any case terminating no later than 30.4.2025.

**Deadline for applications: 11th July 2023 at 04:00 PM (Italian time)**

General information about the selection procedure can be found below. Candidates are invited to review the official announcement (*Bando*) and to follow exclusively its detailed instructions should they decide to apply.

***How to apply***

Candidates with all the aforementioned requisites who wish to participate in the selection process must submit their application exclusively online, using the online dedicated PICA procedure at the following link:

The PICA app can be accessed via SPID, by choosing the institution “Scuola Normale Superiore” from the page of available federations; alternatively, the procedure will necessarily require an e-mail address in order to register into the system.

Until the deadline for the submission of applications, the procedure can save any data inserted in draft mode, enabling their modification and/or integration.

By the established deadline, applications for participation in the selection must be filled in definitively in all their parts, signed, on pain of exclusion, in one of the modes indicated by the online procedure, and submitted – together with all the attachments – by means of the same online procedure.

No signature will be required when submitting the application only if the SPID is used to access procedure.

The date of online submission will be certified by the PICA procedure; candidates will be notified of the receipt of their applications and their subsequent registration by means of two separate e-mail messages. Each application will be attributed a separate identification number (application ID) and a registration number, both visible inside the application; the application ID must be used, together with the call code **23-TEC-Bio-01**, for any subsequent communications.

Once applications have been submitted online and the confirmation of the online PICA procedure has been received, it will no longer be possible to access them in order to modify them; they may only be withdrawn using the function “ritira/Withdraw” on the initial page of the procedure. Candidates can, however, submit a new application. After the deadline for submission, the online procedure will no longer permit access or the online transmission of applications. Please note that the online procedure may undergo temporary suspensions for technical reasons.

**No other form of transmission of applications and/or documentation for participation in the selection is allowed other than those indicated above.** Solely in the case of proven and certified technical unavailability of the online PICA procedure, the Scuola reserves the right to accept admission applications and/or supporting documentation submitted in other modes, provided they are transmitted before the call deadline.

### ***Qualifications submission procedure***

–Candidates with European Union citizenship must prove that they are in possession of the qualifications that they intend to submit for assessment in their application by providing the indications required in the dedicated sections of the online application (failure to provide these in adequate detail may result in their not being assessed) and submitting any attachments required. The veracity of the indications in their application and the conformity to the original of the documents attached is attested by candidates, pursuant to Arts. 46 and 47 of D.P.R. No. 445/2000, in the section relating to the declarations of responsibility in the online PICA procedure for the submitting of applications.

–Non-EU citizens with a regular residence permit may submit a self-certification affidavit only when it is necessary to provide proof of status, facts or personal qualities certifiable or confirmable by Italian public agencies, without prejudice to the special dispositions of the laws and regulations concerning immigration and the rights of foreign citizens, under art. 3 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000.

–Non-EU citizens can submit a self-certification affidavit also in those cases when the production of self-executed certificates takes place under international agreements between Italy or the European Union and the applicant's country of origin.

Other than in the above mentioned cases, for non-Italian citizens the state, personal qualities and facts stated in the application are proved by loading the online PICA procedure for the qualifications in PDF format or of the relative certificates/attestations issued by the competent authorities of the non-Italian State in question. L'esibizione degli originali di detti documenti può essere richiesta dalla commissione in sede di prova orale e, in ogni caso, l'Amministrazione si riserva di richiederli all'atto dell'eventuale assunzione.

The commission may ask candidates to produce the originals of the said documents at the oral test; in any case, the Administration reserves the right to request them at the time of recruitment of the successful candidate.

### **Documentation in foreign languages:**

Qualifications and documents in English, French, German and Spanish can be submitted in their original language. All the qualifications and documents in any other language must be submitted together with a translation into Italian, English, French, German, or Spanish. The translation must be authenticated by law with certification of conformity with the original.

No reference may be made to documents submitted to this or other administrations or to documents attached to the application forms of other selection procedures.
